* * * SWIMMING POOL RULES and REGULATIONS rev 06-27-07 * * *

The following **Rules and Regulations** are for the protection and benefit of all to assure safe and sanitary operations of the pool and facilities. Your cooperation in abiding by these conditions will afford pleasant relaxation and recreation for **all** concerned. **Parents are required to caution their children** to observe all rules and regulations and obey the instructions of all employees.

Failure to comply with any of these rules shall be considered sufficient cause for any action deemed necessary by the pool management company, CMI, or the DCA Board of Directors., including the barring of violators from the pool area.

- 1) The pool is operated by a qualified and responsive pool contractor. Comments regarding lifeguards supervision or any other pool related issue should be directed to CMI or the DCA Board of Directors.
- 2) Lifeguards are on duty **to assure your safety**. *Please assist them by being a safe and courteous swimmer and by following their instructions.* Those not complying with the rules, or who conduct themselves in any way dangerous to themselves or others, **may be removed from the pool at the lifeguard's discretion**.
- 3) 15-minute swim periods for adults 18 & over will be provided every hour at the lifeguard's discretion. No one under 18 will be allowed in the pool during this time.
- 4) The pool may be closed at any time at the lifeguard's discretion for reasons such as equipment breakdowns, operational difficulties, or inclement weather, etc.
- 5) All persons using the pool **MUST** present pool passes to gain admission. Pool passes are not transferable.
- 6) Admission will be refused to anyone with skin abrasions, colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, infections or wearing bandages.
- 7) *Members will be responsible for all actions of their guests.* The cost of property damage will be charged to the member.
- 8) The manager or his agents will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to, any personal property of any kind of members or guests.
- 9) All trash must be put in containers in the pool area. Please help to keep the area clean.
- 10) No one may use the pool unless it is officially open and a lifeguard is on duty.
- 11) No bicycles, roller-skates, roller blades, or skateboards will be allowed in the pool area.
- 12) No spitting or blowing your nose in the pool.
- 13) No diving. The sole exception being swim team members at practices or meets.
- 14) No food or drink within ten (10) feet of pool's perimeter.
- 15) No smoking.
- 16) No alcohol permitted. Persons who appear to be under the influence of alcohol or other controlled substances will not to be permitted into the facility.
- 17) No life preservers, inner tubes, or other flotation devices will be used unless approved by pool manager.
- 18) **No pushing, dunking, wrestling, or any other horseplay will be permitted.**
- 19) No pets.
- 20) **No abusive or profane language will be tolerated.**
- 21) No gum chewing.
- 22) No loud stereos or televisions allowed in the pool area.
- 23) Members under 12 must be accompanied by a member who is 16 or older.
- 24) Guests must be accompanied by a member who is 16 or older at all times. Guests must leave the facility if their resident leaves.
- 25) All patrons must shower (soap shower) before using the pool.
- 26) All infants and toddlers must wear swim diapers - no disposable diapers.
- 27) All infants or young children using flotation devices must be within the reach of a water-safe adult at all times.

These rules may be amended, added to, or subtracted from at the sole discretion of the DCA Pool Committee or Board of Directors, their management company, or the pool managers. Current rules will be posted at the pool facility and on the community website at www.dearbought.com
